



## GUIDE SHEET: MEDICAL KIT

## LABEL AND TRY TO USE THESE WORDS IN CONVERSATION WITH YOUR CHILD THIS WEEK:

New Words: medical kit

**Relationships:** 

on your arm in and out of the bag look into your ears <u>Concepts:</u> listening squeezing helping <u>Body Parts:</u> eyes nose ears mouth heart arms

syringe blood pressure cuff

<u>Shapes and Sizes:</u> long too big round

Describe your actions. Encourage your child to describe actions.

- <u>Invite your child to tell about his/her experiences</u>: Have you been to the doctor? Can you put the bandage on your wrist?
- <u>Activities</u>: Pretend your doll or teddy bear is sick. Can you give him a check up and make him feel better?
- <u>Sounds</u>: Listen to your heart with the stethoscope. Listen to the sound the blood pressure cuff makes!



## REMEMBER

Encourage your child to TALK ASK the child questions LISTEN to the child's answers ADD to his/her comments ENCOURAGE Curiosity Imagination Independence

Encourage the child to WANT TO LEARN PRAISE when the child does well Try to IGNORE mistakes HELP when the child really needs it
