LABEL AND TRY TO USE THESE WORDS IN CONVERSATION WITH YOUR CHILD THIS WEEK:

Describe your actions. Encourage your child to describe actions.

- General: *Let's build a block tower together.*
- Sorting and Matching: *I am going to put all the squares here and all the rectangles over there. Can you find another blue square? Can you find all of the red blocks?*
- Fitting: *Let's see if we can put these two blocks inside of each other. Can we fit the blocks back in the box?*
- Sounds: *Let's listen to the sound of these two blocks hitting each other. Now let's listen to the sound of these two blocks rubbing each other.*

REMEMBER



Encourage your child to TALK
ASK the child questions
LISTEN to the child's answers
ADD to his/her comments

Encourage the child to WANT TO LEARN
PRAISE when the child does well
Try to IGNORE mistake
HELP when the child really needs it
