



GUIDE SHEET: SOCK PUPPETS

LABEL AND TRY TO USE THESE WORDS IN CONVERSATION WITH YOUR CHILD THIS WEEK:

Body Parts:

eyes nose body hair teeth ears arms <u>Shapes:</u> round eyes oval nose triangle pizza

<u>Textures:</u> soft fur hard eyes fuzzy hair

<u>Numbers:</u> many teeth two eyes one nose <u>Emotions:</u> happy silly

Describe your actions. Encourage your child to describe actions.

- <u>General:</u> Let's put the puppets together. What parts can you see?
- <u>Sorting</u>: How are you going to make him look happy? Can you make him have two arms? How many eyes does he have? Let's put all the eyes in a pile.
- <u>Fitting:</u> Let's see where we can put the arms. Where should his eyes go? Where does the nose fit?
- <u>Imaginary Play:</u> Let's pretend to be happy, and then silly. Can you make the puppet clap? Can you feed the puppet?



REMEMBER

Encourage the child to WANT TO LEARN PRAISE when the child does well Try to IGNORE mistake HELP when the child really needs it

Encourage your child to TALK ASK the child questions LISTEN to the child's answers ADD to his/her comments
