## Describe your actions. Encourage your child to describe actions.

- <u>Invite your child to tell his/her experience.</u> Have you ever seen a bunny before? How about a bumblebee?
- <u>Ask questions about the pictures to help your child reason things out:</u> Can you find all of the bunnies on the page? Are they hiding?
- <u>Counting</u>: Together with your child, count all of the bunnies on the pages.

ENCOURAGE Curiosity Imagination Independence REMEMBER

Encourage your child to TALK ASK the child questions LISTEN to the child's answers ADD to his/her comments





Encourage the child to WANT TO LEARN PRAISE when the child does well Try to IGNORE mistakes HELP when the child really needs it
